The Borough of Abbottstown is a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

Under the authority of section 504 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10504, Abbottstown has enacted a Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (SALDO) by which it reviews and approves proposed plans for development; and

Under section 702 of the SALDO, Abbottstown Borough Council shall by resolution create a schedule of fees to be paid to defray the cost of administering and processing plans for development; and

Among other matters, the fees cover the costs of the municipal engineer and solicitor for reviewing plans for development and determining compliance with the Zoning Ordinance and SALDO, making site inspections and reviewing cost estimates required for public improvements; and

The appointed engineer for Abbottstown, Keller Engineers., and the appointed solicitor for Abbottstown, Salzmann Hughes, have established schedules of fees for 2024 (Fee Schedule) for professional fees and out-of-pocket costs; and

The Fee Schedule (attached hereto as Exhibit A) is reasonable for services provided to Abbottstown Borough residents in connection with the SALDO requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fee Schedule is hereby approved for purposes of professional fees levied by Abbottstown Borough on applicants for subdivision and land development review and related services.
