A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF ABBOTTSTOWN, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, NAMING THE BRIDGE AT BEAVER CREEK ON COUNTRY CLUB ROAD RESOLUTION NO. 2024 -

Whereas;

The Borough of Abbottstown is a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and,

A one lane bridge currently exists over the Beaver Creek on Country Club Road just south of the intersection with East Fleet Street, which has been deemed a "Scour 4" by Pennoni, a bridge engineering firm working with PennDOT to identify deteriorating bridges; and,

Dr. David William Scott Bolton, PhD, MBA, CBO, is the current Abbottstown Borough Manager who has held the position of Adams County Transportation Planning Organization Vice-Chair previously and advocated for federal and state funding to replace the old bridge with a new, two-lane bridge, and improvements to the adjacent roadways; and,

Dr. Bolton has successfully acquired up to Ninety-Five Percent (95%) of the costs of bridge replacement and improvement through state and federal grant monies; outside of the Marcellus Shale Funds that Adams County had previously received for such projects; and,

Abbottstown Borough's contribution to the bridge replacement project total of \$620,000 will be only \$31,000; and,

Dr. Bolton continues to coordinate with PennDOT, Navarro & Wright (bridge engineers), Keller Engineers (borough), and eventually the winning contractors who will install the bridge to ensure the project is completed successfully to serve the borough residents for decades to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. Abbottstown Borough Council bequeaths the name "Bolton Bridge" to the project to honor the tremendous efforts of Dr. Bolton to secure the grant funding for the project.
- 2. Dr. Bolton is directed to order the appropriate signage to identify the name of the project, and to have same installed at either side of the current bridge location.
- 3. This Resolution was adopted by a motion and approval by a majority vote of the members of the Abbottstown Borough Council at a duly advertised meeting.
